**Welcome to St James's on the 13th Sunday after Trinity**

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ, when Peter tries to deny the Lord his Passion—"Far be it from you, Lord! This shall never happen to you."—the Lord rebukes him. Why? Because Christ's death on the cross would fulfil the "good and acceptable and perfect" will of the Father for our salvation. In union with Jesus, we offer our bodies as a living sacrifice to God: this is one of the central Anglican beliefs about the part we play in the Eucharistic offering. And no matter how much our sharing in Christ's cross may make us an object of the world's laughter and mockery, the love of God is like a fire burning in our heart. This love, in all its life-giving glory, is what Christ reveals on the cross.
